Info:	This is a characteristic round dance, from which I was able to
	identify a few remnants of the steps. Through field research, I
	reconstructed its initial or basic form. It consists of one
	primary step and two additional variations. In our traditional
	dance performances, we gradually increase the tempo,
	resulting in changes in the dance steps.

Posture:	For belts.
Gender:	Mixed.

Info:	Quite a well-known dance, which has been featured in many
	choreographic productions by various choreographers. We
	studied the traditional form of the Berovka dance.
	Etymologically, the name indicates that it belongs to city of
	Berovo, implying it is a dance originating from or associated
	with the city of Berovo. It is performed in the style of
	traditional dances practiced in Berovo. Our study focused on
	the basic variant and the first variation of the dance
